Note:

The students are registered for a minimum of six credits to maintain loan eligibility. As you can see, to be able to keep the students in the fall match in the number of credits needed each semester for loan eligibility, the MHS would be taken at the end of the program process.

Note that all dates are examples of semester start and end dates for the Master in Nutrition.

For students not tied to loan eligibility needs, course schedules can be designed to lighten some semesters while in DI supervised practice (e.g., MHS 601 can be added to their first semester at Cedar Crest, reducing course load to capstone only in their final DI semester. We also offer the half-semester MHS 620 Sports Nutrition course in the summer session, which begins in the first week of July for those who want a jump start and a lighter load during their supervised practice and first semester of Capstone. These types of course schedule adjustments would be available for both the Fall and Spring Match group. These changes will not reduce the time to completion.

Degree conferral date examples (on or about) May 13th, August 26th, and January 2nd.
